“5 – QUALITIES” OF A DANGEROUS LIFE:

1) AN **UNCIVILIZED** APPROACH.

In those days John the Baptist came, preaching... 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near...' John's clothes were made of camel's hair, and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey. People went out to him...Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River. [Matthew 3:1-6](#)

Jesus entered the temple area and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and... said to them, 'My house will be called a house of prayer,' but you are making it a den of robbers.' [Matthew 21:12-13](#)

2) A DIVINE **BOLDNESS**.

Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. Stretch out your hand to heal and perform miraculous signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus. [Acts 4:29-30](#)

3) A **RISK-TAKING** FAITH

And without faith it is impossible to please God... [Hebrews 11:6](#)

For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it. [Matthew 16:25](#)

4) AN **UNSHAKABLE** DEVOTION.

‘ We gave you strict orders not to teach in this name,’ he said. ‘Yet you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and are determined to make us guilty of this man's blood.’ Peter and the other apostles replied: **We must obey God rather than men!**

~ Acts 5:28-29

They called the apostles in and had them flogged. (beaten, torn up) Then they ordered them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name. ~Acts 5:40-41

5) A **CONSUMING** FOCUS.

But Peter and John replied, ‘Judge for yourselves whether it is right in God's sight to obey you rather than God. For we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard.’ Acts 4:19-20

The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name. Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Christ. Acts 5:41-42
